GAAHBSU Legislative Conference Overview

Through the course of history, Albany State, Fort Valley State, and Savannah State Universities' alumni and other supporters have met to ensure the continued existence, growth, and advancement of these three unique higher educational institutions.

As early as 1982, three alumni David Gibson (ASU), Thomas Dortch (FVSU), and Roy L. Jackson collaborated to create a mechanism to foster a collective effort to generate support for the three-state historically black institutions. That mechanism evolved into the organization "Tri College Alumni Group". The purpose of the group was to bring alumni from each institution together in January as a unified group for an Annual Legislative Conference during the Georgia General Assembly.

In January 1986, the name was changed to "Georgia Alumni Association of Black State Colleges." In 1997 the name changed again to "Georgia Alumni Association of Black State Universities". In 2009 the name was officially changed to "Georgia Alumni Association of Historically Black State Universities (GAAHBSU)" to reflect the unique distinction of the three universities. The association continues to convene its Annual Legislative Conference during the Georgia General Assembly to fulfill the purpose for which it was founded.

GAAHBSU Purpose

GAAHBSU is a consortium of the National Alumni Associations of Albany State, Fort Valley State, and Savannah State Universities. GAAHBSU was established to advance the mission, enhance the image, and help ensure the future of these universities. The association represents more than 60,000 graduates worldwide, with some 45,000 residing in Georgia.

The Annual GAAHBSU Legislative Conference provides a forum for alumni, university officials, state policymakers, and other key state leaders to engage in effective dialogue, assess needs and develop and implement strategies that will assure the continued growth and equitable enhancement of Albany State, Fort Valley State and Savannah State Universities within the University System of Georgia.

Teresa MacCartneyActing Chancellor of the University System of Georgia

Teresa MacCartney became acting chancellor of the University System of Georgia on July 1, 2021. She oversees 26 public colleges and universities with a \$9.8 billion annual budget, 48,000 faculty and staff, and more than 341,000 students. The Georgia Public Library System and the Georgia Archives are also part of the University System, which has been recognized nationally for its efforts in cost savings and student attainment.

Prior to becoming acting chancellor, MacCartney was USG's executive vice chancellor for administration. In that role, she oversaw the university system's day-to-day management of departments that included cybersecurity, leadership and institutional development, economic development, legal affairs, organizational effectiveness, human resources, real estate and facilities, internal audits, and safety and security.

Before joining USG, MacCartney served as Georgia's chief financial officer as well as director of the Governor's Office of Planning and Budget. She has held several other leadership roles throughout state government, including with the Georgia Student Finance Commission and the Georgia Department of Education. She serves on several boards, including as vice president of Leadership Georgia, and is a member of the Board of Directors of the Georgia Lottery Corporation.

MacCartney earned both a bachelor's degree in mathematics and a Master of Public Administration degree from Georgia Southern University.





Senator Lester G. Jackson, III Senate District 2

A family dentist from Savannah, Georgia, Dr. Lester G. Jackson, III, is providing exceptional dental services to the Savannah/Chatham County area for over two decades. Partnered with his wife, Dr. Lorna C. Jackson, The Jackson Dental Center is a cornerstone of dental services for the coastal region of the state.

Dr. Jackson currently serves in the Georgia General Assembly as a three-term senator, representing the 2nd district. Dr. Jackson was first elected to the legislature in 1998. While in the Georgia House of Representatives, he was voted by his peers as Freshman Legislator of the Year. After serving in the Georgia House of Representatives for 10 years, Dr. Jackson was elected to the State Senate, where he currently serves as Chairman of the Senate Urban Affairs Committee. Dr. Jackson is a nationally renowned healthcare provider who has received numerous awards, including being honored by the Georgia Dental Association as the Legislator of the Year and he received the Distinguished Service Award from the National Dental Association. In addition, Dr. Jackson was voted by his legislative peers as the Georgia Legislative Black Caucus Legislator of the Year and currently serves as the chairman of the Georgia Legislative Black Caucus, the largest in the nation. After graduating from Meharry Medical College in 1985, Dr. Jackson was commissioned as a naval officer, proudly serving seven years as a dental officer for the United States Navy. He obtained the rank of Lt. Commander in four years and served as Detachment Commander of the Beaufort Marine Corp. Air Station Dental Clinic, in Beaufort, South Carolina. As the Detachment Commander, Dr. Jackson provided dental services to military personnel and their families. In 1991, after serving his country with distinction, he later established the Jackson Dental Center in Savannah, Georgia. The Jackson Dental Center is a part of the Minority and Women Businesses Enterprise (MWBE).

Dr. Jackson is the CEO of Coastal Health Solutions, Inc. (CHS). CHS recognizes the growing need to promote and employ dental allied health professionals who are experts in their field. Dr. Jackson and the Jackson Dental Center moved into this phase of growth with a vision for further advancement. Located in the Coastal Empire of the South; Coastal Health Solutions Inc. is a private agency that provides staffing, management resources, and services for various needs of the dental and allied health industry. Rep. William K. Boddie, Jr. House Representative District 62

William K. Boddie, Jr. was born in Atlanta, Georgia, and raised in South Fulton County. He graduated from Banneker High School in College Park, Georgia, in 1995. After graduating high school, William attended Valdosta State University in Valdosta, Georgia, where he graduated in 1999 with a Bachelor of Science in criminal justice.

He received his Juris Doctor from the Mercer Walter F. George School of Law in Macon, Georgia, in 2003 and has been licensed to practice law in the state since 2005. He is the cofounder and managing partner of The Boddie McKnight Law Firm, LLC with offices in both Douglas and Fulton counties. He was elected to the House of Representatives in 2016 and represents the citizens of House District 62, which includes portions of Douglas and Fulton counties. He served as House Minority Whip from 2019 to 2021.

William is actively involved in professional organizations, such as the Georgia Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers (GACDL), the Georgia Trial Lawyers Association (GTLA), and the Cobb County Bar Association. He is also a member of the South Fulton Chamber of Commerce (SFCOC), the Douglas County Chamber of Commerce, the Douglas County Small Business Society, the City of Douglasville Housing Committee, and the Douglas County Democratic Party.

His community service through nonprofit organizations includes roles as an advisory council member and community liaison for the Fulton Leadership Academy (FLA) in East Point, Georgia, an organizer and conference speaker for Let Us Make Men (LUMM), and an active member of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc.

He has served as a faculty member for the Personal Development Academy of the Georgia Association of Black Women Attorneys (GABWA). He frequently serves as a guest lecturer and panelist at universities around the state, including Valdosta State University, Morehouse College, Columbus State University, Clark Atlanta University, and West Georgia University.

William is a well sought-after legal analyst and has been featured in the Atlanta Journal-Constitution, the Douglas County Sentinel, the Fulton County Daily Report, and Ebony Magazine. He has also been interviewed regarding high-profile cases and developing legal issues by FOX 5 News, 11Alive News, Channel 2 Action News, and dctv23 in Douglas County. William serves as a legal commentator and town hall speaker for V-103 and WAOK 1380 radio stations.

William is a life-long member of Antioch Baptist Church in North Atlanta.



Nicole Horn Georgia Labor Commissioner 2022 Candidate

Nicole Horn is a former business owner and current Democratic candidate for Georgia Labor Commissioner. Over the course of her life, Nicole has waitressed at Waffle House, sold knives door to door, leased corporate apartments, and grown a small business, to name just a few jobs. Nicole understands what it's like to count every penny from an hourly job to balancing a budget for a business. These experiences inform her work and how she plans to lead the Department of Labor.

After college, she worked as a television reporter in Dothan, Alabama, and then at WMAZ in Macon. While at WMAZ, Nicole covered Robins Air Force Base during the events of 9-11 and the period following.

Marion Ross Fedrick, Ed.D.

President of Albany State University

Marion Ross Fedrick was appointed as the 10th president of Albany State University on August 14, 2018, by the University System of Georgia Board of Regents. She was appointed after serving as both the interim executive vice president and interim president for the University since October 2017. President Fedrick is an accomplished senior leader whose proven expertise spans over 30 years. Her professional background includes higher education administration, strategic planning, crisis management, and strategic partnership management in both the private and public sectors.

Committed to the impact of academic development, Fedrick believes every student deserves access to an excellent and affordable education. Fedrick is a three-time graduate of the University of Georgia with a bachelor's degree in adult education, concentration in organizational development, master's degree in public administration, and doctorate degree in higher education management.

As president of Albany State University, Fedrick continues to apply her diverse experiences and commitment to drive initiatives that ignite excellence. Under her leadership, the institution has undertaken several critical initiatives that include a redesign of the institution's academic colleges, approval of the University System of Georgia's first nexus degrees, and the design and implementation of the university's integrated student success model to include the creation of the Albany State University Summer Success Institute.

The intersection of her vision, passion, and broad leadership capabilities have placed her in key leadership roles throughout her career. Serving as the USG vice chancellor of human resources, Fedrick has led strategic initiatives relating to effective university administration, leadership development, and all human resources planning efforts at Clark Atlanta University, Emory University Hospitals, State of Georgia's Office of State Personnel Administration, AT&T, and the former BellSouth Corporation.

Recently, Fedrick was named one of the Ten Most Dominant HBCU Leaders by the HBCU Campaign Fund (HCF). This is a national recognition ranking created to acknowledge a select group of leaders who exemplify value-added contributions in higher education and their impact on HBCUs and Minority-Serving Institutions.





Paul A. Jones, Ph.D. President of Fort Valley State University

Paul A. Jones is the 10th president of Fort Valley State University. Recognized for being a visionary leader and strategic thinker with nearly 35 years of higher education experience, President Paul Jones was appointed to take Fort Valley State's helm in December 2015 following a career that included leadership positions in Georgia, Colorado, Maryland, and Utah.

Dr. Jones, an astute and affable administrator, is committed to the transformative power of higher education. He has spent the last several years advancing FVSU's standing as one of the nation's most respected institutions of higher learning, including its consistent ranking as the top public historically black college and university (HBCU) in Georgia by U.S. News and World Reports.

Before joining FVSU, President Jones served two years as interim president at Darton State College (2013-2015) in Albany, Georgia. Throughout his higher education career, he served in numerous senior leadership roles at Georgia College & State University (2002-2013), including senior vice president for finance and administration, vice president and chief of staff, vice president for institutional research and enrollment management, and several interim roles including interim vice president of academic affairs and president. President Jones was also a Professor of Educational Administration at Georgia College.

In 2019, President Jones established a university-wide steering committee to begin an inclusive and collaborative comprehensive strategic planning process to chart the University's next five years. This 2020-2025 plan, Unleashing 21st Century Innovation, Transformation, and Excellence, is currently in the implementation phase and will focus on four priorities: Exceptional Student Experience, Operational Excellence, Organizational Identity, and Engagement and Collaboration.

During President Jones's stabilizing tenure at FVSU, he expanded the academic offerings on the campus and online, bolstered innovative programs focused on student success, and renovated and modernized aging campus structures. He also has increased retention and graduation rates, and FVSU experienced its highest enrollment since fall 2013.

During his investiture, President Jones launched a needs-based campaign to support students. Since its establishment, the program has dramatically increased funding for need-based aid. During this same period, FVSU also experienced consecutive years of increased fundraising and new donors. Under his leadership, several renovation and construction projects have also been completed or are underway, including the Junia J. Fambro Dining Center, Amphitheatre, Center for Agribusiness, Innovation and Entrepreneurship, the Davidson Hall, and numerous other essential projects.

Dr. Jones is also a member of several boards including, The Medical Center of Peach County, Navicent Health Board of Directors, Fort Valley State University Foundation, Middle Georgia Goodwill Industries Education Committee, Association of Public and Land-grant Universities Council of 1890s Officers, USDA-1890 Task Force, Museum of Aviation Foundation Board of Governors, and the Southern Intercollegiate Athletic Conference Executive Board.

Dr. Jones and his wife Sylvia were named 2012 Alumni of the Year at Utah State University, where President Jones earned his bachelor's and master's degrees. The Los Angeles, California-native also earned a Doctor of Philosophy degree in education and human resource studies from Colorado State University. In 2007-08, President Jones served as an American Council on Education (ACE) Fellow at the University of West Florida.

President and First Lady Jones have two adult children: Isaiah and Daphne.





Kimberly Ballard-Washington, J.D.

President of Savannah State University

Savannah State University President Kimberly Ballard-Washington was appointed by the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia on May 13, 2021, after serving as the university's interim president since July 1, 2019.

President Ballard-Washington has practiced law in the state of Georgia for 20 years and most recently served the University System of Georgia (USG) as associate vice chancellor for Legal Affairs and as the assistant secretary to the Board of Regents (BOR). She honed her skills as an advocate for fairness and justice, serving as the BOR's primary legal advisor on student, faculty, and employment issues. This role also gave her the opportunity to work directly with and provide advice and counsel to the USG university presidents and their leadership teams. She was also tasked with leading USG's efforts in (the Education Amendments of 1972's) Title IX administration.

President Ballard-Washington previously served as an associate director for legal affairs at the University of Georgia and as assistant to the president for Legal Affairs and Director of Equal Opportunity Programs at Valdosta State University. In 2013, then-Chancellor Hank Huckaby asked then-associate Vice-Chancellor Ballard-Washington to serve as interim president at Fort Valley State University, followed by an opportunity to lead Albany State University on an interim basis. To date, President Ballard-Washington is the only person to have led all three of Georgia's public Historically Black Colleges and Universities.

Earlier in her career, she was named to Georgia Trend Magazine's "Top 40 under 40" list. In 2019, President Ballard-Washington completed the American Association of State Colleges and Universities (AASCU) Millennium Leadership Institute. She is currently participating in AASCU's New Presidents Academy.

President Ballard-Washington also currently serves on the Board of Directors for the United Way of the Coastal Empire, co-chairing the Race, Equity, and Opportunity Committee. Additionally, she is a member of the Rotary Club of Savannah. She also serves on the Boards of Directors for the Savannah Area Chamber of Commerce, Islands Hospice, Bethesda Academy, and the American Red Cross' Southeast Georgia Chapter.

Born and raised in Montezuma, Georgia, President Ballard-Washington received a Bachelor of Arts degree from the University of Georgia. She earned her Juris Doctorate at Texas Southern University's Thurgood Marshall School of Law, where she was a leader in the Black Law Students Association and the Student Bar Association.

President Ballard-Washington's career has been balanced by her role as wife to her husband, Craig, and as the mother to two incredible daughters, Kristen and Kerri.
